

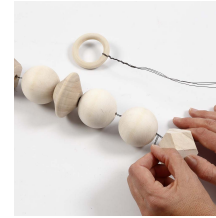


A Mobile made from Florist Wire with Magnets for hanging Photos etc.

STEP BY STEP 023
Inspiration: 14586



Cut three equal lengths of florist wire (as long as you like). Twist these together and attach them with a twist around a curtain ring. (This is practical when hanging the finished mobile from the ceiling or on the wall). A TIP: You may make a loop in the florist wire as an alternative.



Thread the large different beads onto the twisted pieces of florist wire and finish with a knot. Attach various photos, drawings and cards onto the mobile using magnets.



Florist Wire, thickness 0.5 mm, black, 50m 517220



Curtain Ring, D: 55 mm, inner size 40 mm, grass wood, 6pcs 56499



Curtain Ring, D: 35 mm, inner size 20 mm, grass wood, 8pcs 56498



Wooden Bead, D: 50 mm, hole size 8 mm, grass wood, 4pcs 56678



Disc-Shaped Bead, D: 63 mm, hole size 8 mm, poplar wood, 3pcs, H: 42 mm 56127



Diamond-Shaped Bead, W: 43 mm, hole size 8 mm, pine, 3pcs 56126

Diamond-Shaped Bead, W: 20 mm, hole size 3 mm, pine, 6pcs 56125

Magnet, H: 13 mm, D: 9-12 mm, 20pcs 57525

A Mobile made from Florist Wire with Magnets for hanging Photos etc.

This long mobile, made from three pieces of twisted florist wire attached to a curtain ring, is decorated with large wooden beads at the bottom. Various hanging decorations are attached onto the mobile with strong magnets which are covered with a small wooden disc. □ □
